

DIPLADENIA BOLIVIENSIS.

LLIED in many respects to Dipladenia urophylla, the new species which we now introduce to the notice of our readers is a perfectly distinct plant, and a welcome addition to our stove climbers. It differs from the species just referred to in its leaves, which are less strongly acuminate, and its flowers, which are white, and have a more slender tube. It is, in fact, a



white Dipladenia with flowers corresponding in size with those of the species above named.
